Beyond church attendance-related crimes, however, criminal punishment was often quite gritty and savage. As in England, property crimes were some of the most common criminal infractions in colonial America. Those who committed an act of burglary, general theft, seditious libel, or a similar crime were typically punished via branding. Burglars were given a capital "B" on their right hand, while thieves received a branded "T."
