MOOD: (sometimes called atmosphere) the overall feeling of the work Mood is the emotions that you (the reader) feel while you are reading.

While the mood is a more internal aspect to the reader the tone of a work is the approach the author takes to the work leaving us to determine the author's attitude of the subject they are exploring. The tone is often dictated by the word choice an author decides upon.
